The International Astronautical Federation, IAF, has announced the group of IAF Young Space Leaders 2020, among them the very first recipient of the ASE Europe – ISU scholarship grant, Ms. Emmanuelle David. The IAF choice confirms the promising space career outlook which brought the ASE Executive Committee to award a scholarship to Ms. David in 2013, enabling her to attend the ISU Space Sciences Programme that summer. As with other scholarship recipients, ASE fosters the career development of young emerging space professionals to which it yearly awards financial support and the opportunity, to exchange views and visions with the astronaut members of ASE.
